

Bureau of Justice Assistance Prevalent Types of Applicants The most prevalent type of applicants were police, sheriff, and other law enforcement agencies, which made up 35 percent of the total number of eligible applications received (exhibit 4). The next largest category was multiagency applications (16 percent), some of which consisted of a police department partnering with a noncriminal justice agency, such as a local public school, to formulate and implement a school violence reduction program. In other situations, law enforcement and probation agencies pro-posed to work together to better supervise those on probation. The next largest group was prosecutors (9 percent). Few applications were received from state corrections agencies (4 percent), public defenders (4 percent), probation and parole agencies (2 percent), tribal agencies (2 percent), public schools (2 percent), or...
